Bookworm Bookmarks!

YOU'LL NEED: CRAFT STICK, POMPOMS, GLUE, GOOGLY EYES (OR PAPER TO CUT OUT EYES)



- You can use markers, paint, stickers, or tape to DECORATE your stick.
- Lay the stick flat, then **GLUE** one pompom to the top of it (on the flat side).
- Add a drop of glue to one side of that pompom, and PRESS together. Repeat that on the other side. Now you have 3 pompoms in a row! You can add more pompoms to either, but make sure your worm doesn't become too heavy!
- **GLUE** one pompom to the **TOP** of the end pompom to make a head, and finish with googly eyes.
- Let the glue dry overnight. Then, use your bookworm on a stick to mark your placeshe'll crawl along the top of the pages!
