

Bookworm Bookmarks!

YOU'LL NEED: CRAFT STICK, POMPOMS, GLUE, GOOGLY EYES (OR PAPER TO CUT OUT EYES)



- You can use markers, paint, stickers, or tape to **DECORATE** your stick.
- Lay the stick flat, then **GLUE** one pom-pom to the top of it (on the flat side).
- Add a drop of glue to one side of that pom-pom, and **PRESS** together. Repeat that on the other side. Now you have 3 pom-poms in a row! You can add more pom-poms to either, but make sure your worm doesn't become too heavy!
- **GLUE** one pom-pom to the **TOP** of the end pom-pom to make a head, and finish with googly eyes.
- Let the glue dry overnight. Then, use your bookworm on a stick to mark your place—she'll crawl along the top of the pages!



Did you know...?

Since books are made from trees, worms technically **COULD** eat a book...but they would never choose to! Worms get all their nutrients from the soil.
