

# Night Landscapes!

YOU'LL NEED: BLACK PAPER, SCRAP PAPER, COTTON BALLS, SCISSORS, GLUE, STICKS, GOOGLY EYES (OPTIONAL)

## EYES IN THE FOREST

- Start with a black piece of paper to be the nighttime sky.
- **TEAR** strips of scrap paper to create the ground. Is your ground covered in green grass? Is it snowy? Is it covered in leaves?
- Add trees, bushes, a cave, etc. to your landscape- you can use scrap paper, or find some sticks and leaves from outside. Glue them down.
- It's time to add your **NOCTURNAL** animals! They're good at hiding, so all we will see is their eyes peering out- you can add pairs of googly eyes, or cut some out of paper.



## OWLS ON A BRANCH

- Start with a black piece of paper to be the nighttime sky.
- **CUT** out tree branches from scraps of paper and **GLUE** it to your sky.
- To make the owls, gently **FLUFF** a cotton ball by tearing and pulling it apart. Then, glue your fluffy piece to the paper so your owl is sitting on a branch. Use more than one cotton ball if you want to make wings, or a bigger owl.
- You can finish by adding eyes, a beak to your owl and a moon and stars to your sky.



*Tip!*

Use white, gray, or silver crayons to show up on black construction paper!
