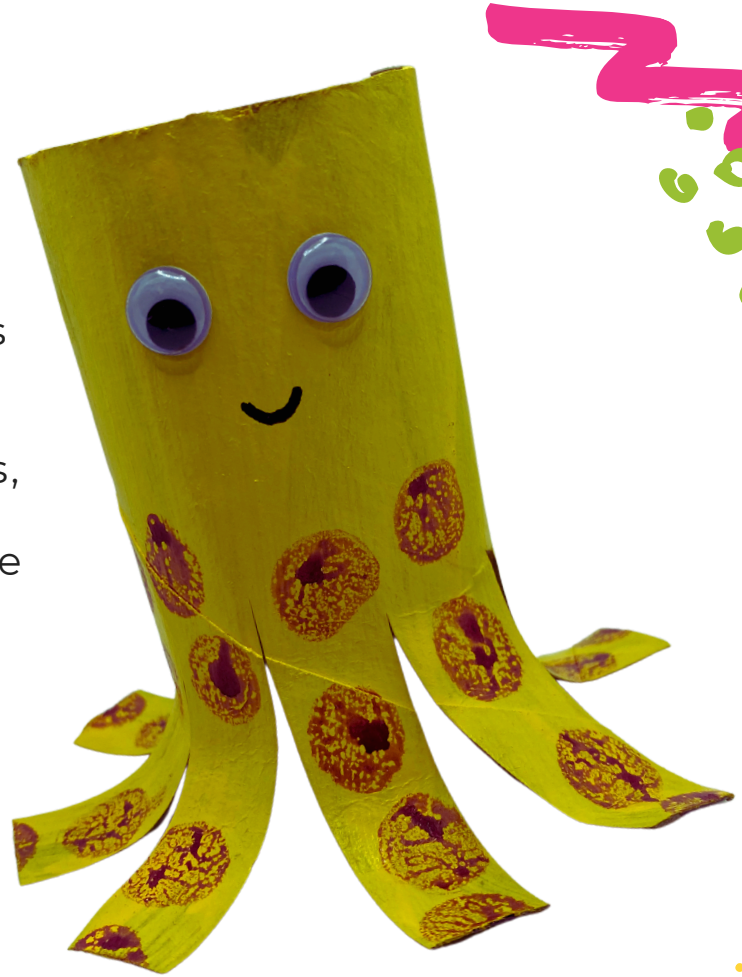


# PAPER TUBE OCTOPUS!

YOU'LL NEED: PAPER TUBE, PAINT OR MARKERS, SCISSORS, GOOGLE EYES (OPTIONAL)

- **COLOR** a paper tube for your octopus. You can use any colors or design you want.
- **OCTO** means **EIGHT**, so an octo-pus has 8 tentacle style legs! **CUT** legs for your octopus by starting at one end, and making cuts about 2 inches long. If you want to have 8 legs, each one should be about half an inch wide, but you can make them slightly different sizes, too!



- Finish up your octopus by adding designs, a face, and round **SUCKERS** going up and down each leg. Octopus suckers are really strong and help them move, as well as hold onto food and surfaces.

*Did you know...?*

An octopus in nature uses **CAMOUFLAGE**: its skin changes color to match its surroundings!
