

# 3D CUPCAKE CARD!

YOU'LL NEED: THICK PAPER, CUPCAKE LINER, SCISSORS, COTTON BALLS, GLUE, CONSTRUCTION PAPER SCRAPS

## 1. BASE

- We often create art that lies **FLAT**, but for this project, we're going to make something that sticks out- that's called **3D**!
- Start with a card shaped piece of thick paper, like cardstock or cardboard. Add a **RECTANGLE** of glue a few inches long, a few inches from the bottom of the card.
- Open up a cupcake liner like you are going to use it. Hold the side that's closest to you, and carefully press the **OPPOSITE** side into the glue. See how the liner sticks out from the paper?



## 2. FILL CUPCAKE

- Now start filling up your cupcake- add a drop of glue to a cotton ball and press it to the back of the card, starting down in the cupcake liner and piling them up as you go. Make sure not to put too many in the bottom of the cupcake liner, or it will get too heavy.

## 3. BIRTHDAY WISHES

- When you're done, cut a thin strip of paper and a flame shape and tape to the top of your cupcake to make a candle. You can decorate the rest of the card, or add a birthday message to the front or the back.
