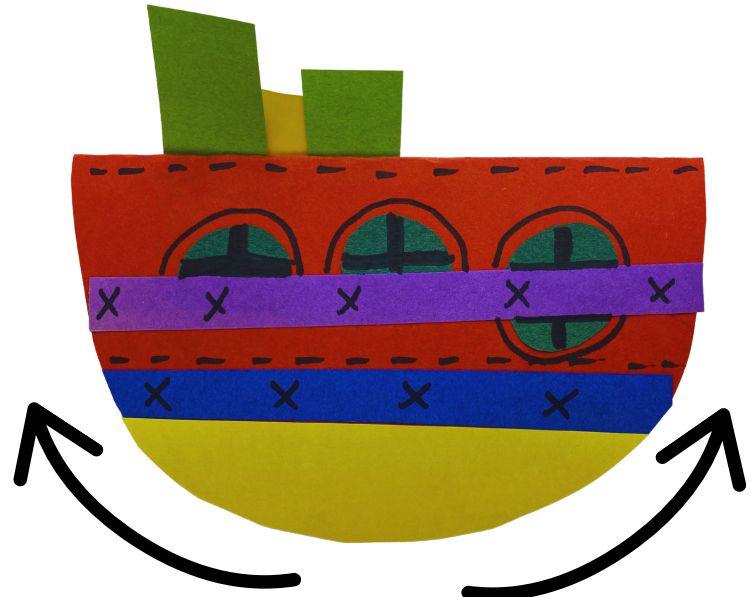


# Rocking Boats!

YOU'LL NEED: CONSTRUCTION PAPER, TAPE/GLUE, SCISSORS, MARKERS/CRAYONS

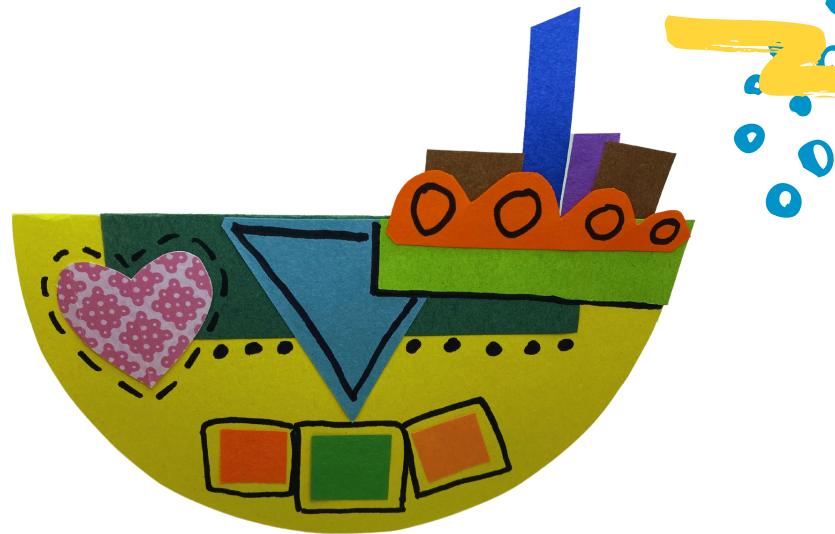
## 1. MAKE YOUR BASE

- **FOLD** a piece of construction paper in half. Draw an **ARCH** going up from the folded edge and cut it out. When you unfold, you should have a circle. (You can also **TRACE** something that is a circle, and then cut it out.)
- Make sure the circle is still folded, and place the rounded side on the table. See how your boat rocks back and forth?



## 2. CUT OUT SHAPES

- Use scraps of colorful or patterned paper to decorate your boat. This is called **COLLAGE**.
- Just cut or tear shapes out of paper and glue or tape them to your boat. Things you might want to add:
  - windows
  - ladders
  - stripes
  - chimney towers
  - life rafts
  - anchors
  - a flag
  - passengers!
- You can also add details or patterns with markers or crayons.

## 3. PLAY

- **ROLL** your boat back and forth to watch it rock. Enjoy!
