

Cave Ornament!

YOU'LL NEED: CRAFT STICKS, GLUE, SCISSORS, PAPER, MARKERS OR PAINT, COTTON BALLS, YARN (OPTIONAL)



- Make your cave by laying out your craft sticks so they make a **TRIANGLE**. Glue the corners so they stick together.
- While your cave is drying, **TRACE** the shape and **CUT** it out. This will be the inside of your cave.
- **DRAW** a **HIBERNATING** creature on the paper. Who will be sleeping in your cave?

- Once your sticks are securely dried, place glue around the edges of your paper, and **PRESS** the cave triangle on top.
- To finish, decorate your cave! Glue on **COTTON BALLS** to look like snow, add cut out tree or moon shapes, or color on the sticks with markers or paint.
- To hang your ornament, **TAPE** a loop of yarn or ribbon onto the back piece of paper.



Did you know...? 

- Hibernation helps animals escape the cold in wintertime. **ESTIVATION** helps animals escape extreme heat and droughts. Animals like salamanders and hedgehogs may sleep thorough the hot, dry season using estivation.
