SIMPLE CROWNS: 3 WAYS!

YOU'LL NEED: CONSTRUCTION PAPER, SCISSORS, TAPE,
PIPE CLEANERS, DECORATING SUPPLIES

1. PAPER CROWN

Fold a piece of construction paper in half the **LONG** way.

CUT a zigzag line (triangles) all along the folded edge, so that you have two pieces of paper with points.

TAPE the short edges together to make one long piece of spiked paper. **DECORATE** your crown with ribbon, stickers, or scrap paper.

WRAP around your head and tape together so that it fits.



2. PIPE CLEANER TIARA

TWIST two pipe cleaners together to make a long one, then wrap around your head and twist together, so that it fits.

Add shapes to the front by twisting more pipe cleaners on and bending them. You can also cut your pipe cleaners to make smaller shapes. Be careful with the ends of the pipe cleaners!

You can try making triangles, a heart, a star, a twist...so many royal options!



Use the bottom of a piece of construction paper as the base of the crown. **CUT** a shape about halfway up the paper, all the way across.

DECORATE your crown with markers, stickers, or whatever else you like.

Make two **HOLES**, one on each edge of the crown. **TIE** or tape the yarn to one hole, and stretch it across your head so it fits. Then tie or tape the other side.
