Duck Finger Puppets

YOU'LL NEED: CONSTRUCTION PAPER, SCISSORS, GLUE OR TAPE, BAKING LINER, GOOGLY EYES OR MARKER

1. CIRCLES

- You'll need two circles- a larger one for the body, and a smaller one for the head.
- TRACE round objects to get your circles, a cup is a good size for the larger circle. What can you trace for the smaller circle? We used yellow construction paper, but ducks come in many colors, so you can use whatever you like.
- **CUT** out the circles, then use a hole punch or scissors to make holes for your fingers (1 1/2 in - 2 inches should work!)





2. CONSTRUCT

- **GLUE** or tape the head to the body, making sure to leave your finger holes free.
- **CUT** out a paper beak, and add eyes to your duck's face.
- Cut the cupcake liner in half, then **FOLD** that piece in half, to make **TRIANGLE** shape (you can also cut wings out of paper). Attach the wings to the side of your duck.

Put your fingers in the holes- now your puppet is ready for play! Here are some things you can do:

- Make up a story for your duck
- Draw your duck a home. Do they live in a pond? In a house?
- Make your duck a friend
