

# YARN WRAPPED TREES

YOU'LL NEED: CARDBOARD, SCISSORS, TAPE, YARN

- You need a long **RECTANGLE** for a tree trunk, and a rounded **OVAL** for the branches of the tree- with small slits cut into each rounded part. Tape these together to make your cardboard tree.
- Start by **TAPING** one end of a piece of yarn onto the back of your tree. Then wrap the yarn carefully all around the shape- you can slide yarn into the slits as well as the spaces between rounded parts, whatever you like!



- When you've used up the yarn, you can tape it again to the back, and repeat with another color to make a pretty fall tree!
- Threading/weaving yarn is an excellent development technique for finger muscles required in writing.
