## **Clothespin Turkeys!**

YOU'LL NEED: CLOTHESPIN, CONSTRUCTION PAPER, GLUE, LEAVES (REAL OR PAPER), GOOGLE EYES OR MARKER

- Cut a small CIRCLE out of paper for your turkey's head.
- Then, fold a small piece of paper in half, and cut a TRIANGLE out of the folded side. Open the shape a little, and it should look like a little beak.
- Glue the beak to the head, and add eyes- you can draw them, or use google eyes, stickers, or buttons.
- Then, glue the turkey's face to the CLIP end of a clothespin, on the flat part near the top.

- Next, head outside and search for some beautiful leaves! Large, wide leaves, like MAPLE, work great, or you can collect several smaller leaves for each turkey. How many different colors can you find? How many different shapes? If you don't have any fallen leaves nearby, you can also cut some out of paper.
- When you're done, SQUEEZE
  your clothespin open, and add
  some leaves. Shut your
  clothespin around your
  feathers, and look! You've got a
  turkey! You may even be able to
  make your turkey stand up on
  the non-feather end.
