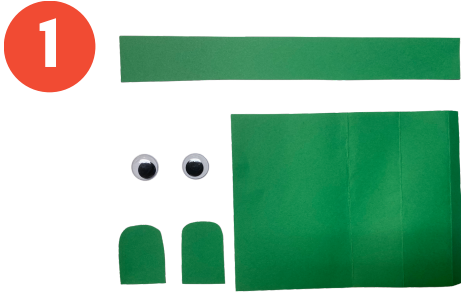


Paper Frogs!

YOU'LL NEED: GREEN CONSTRUCTION PAPER, SCISSORS, TAPE OR GLUE, GOOGLE EYES OR MARKER



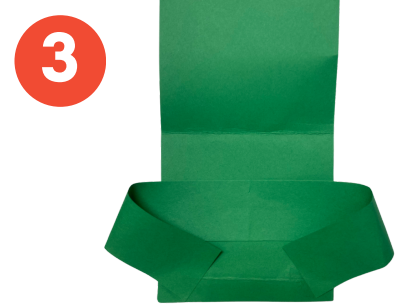
1

Cut 1 long strip the length of the paper. Fold the paper in half, and cut down the middle. Then, cut 2 rounded tabs for eyes.

Fold the rectangle in half like a card. Glue the long piece across the middle of the inside of the card.

Fold one end of the long piece so the corner lines up with the corner of the base. Glue. Then do the other side. Now your frog has legs!

Glue or draw eyes onto the tops of the 2 tabs.



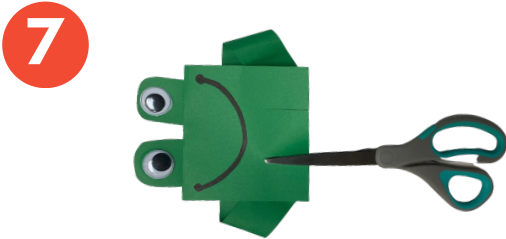

Glue or tape the tabs on the top of the back of your frog's body.

Draw a smile, or a tongue, or a frown on your frog!

Make 2 cuts on the front flap of the frog, about 2 inches long. Fold the tab of paper you just made towards the inside.

Glue or tape the edge of that tab to the back of the frog. This will help him stand up.
